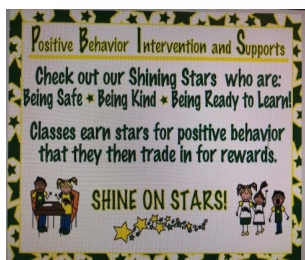


Our Shining Stars are Rockin' it at Northwood

Breakfast and Lunch Program, 2018-2019

We are pleased to inform you that Northwood and Winchester Elementary Schools will be participating in the Community Eligibility Option of the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Program for the 2018-2019 school year. This program provides a healthy breakfast and lunch each day at no charge for ALL students enrolled at Northwood and Winchester Schools.
