Early Release Information

If you need to pick your child up early from school (before dismissal) a note is required with the <u>child's full name and the teacher's</u> <u>name on the note</u>.

You will need ID to enter the building. You should go directly to the attendance office or nurse's office upon arrival.

Custody Arrangements

If there are custody arrangements/limitations involving your child, please make sure the office has updated legal custodial agreements, restraining orders, etc.

The school <u>must remain</u> neutral and follow the most updated court order.

The school <u>must have</u> these documents on file if an issue were to arise.

Transportation

If you need to pick up your child, you MUST provide a written note.

If no written note is received, your child will be sent home by his/her usual method of transportation.

Breakfast/Lunch

Students are provided with a lunch debit account. If you are sending in cash or check to add money to your child's account, please put it in an envelope or baggie labeled with your child's name.
