- ♦ Mastery (85% and above) on your Social Studies Final Examinations

Credit Requirements

You must have completed two (2) Social Studies Courses (Global Studies I, Global Studies II, U.S. History, SUPA Psychology) and earned credits in these courses, and be prepared to complete at least one SUPA or AP social studies class, to apply.

Application Process

Each applicant will complete the attached application. Mrs. Welgoss will be accessing your transcript for grade verification. The completed application will be reviewed by the Rho Kappa Committee, and each applicant will be evaluated based on his or her credentials and character. All Rho Kappa members must be good citizens in the classroom and out of the classroom to be admitted into the Rho Kappa honor society. Candidates must also list two high school teacher references on their application: one high school Social Studies teacher, and one other high school teacher of your choice.

Requirements Once Selected to Become a Member of Rho Kappa

Each member of the Rho Kappa organization will be expected to do the following to maintain membership in Rho Kappa <u>before he or she graduates</u>. All members who fulfill the requirements will earn a CORD upon graduation.

- 1. Complete the 5 hour service requirement for each year of membership (done as a group)
- 2. Participate in one (1) fundraiser (Fowlers Candy late January/ early February)
- 3. Maintain the grade requirements in Social Studies courses and overall GPA
- **4.** Pay a one-time \$10 membership fee (owed upon acceptance for national organization)
- 5. Attend the Rho Kappa initiation, introductory meeting, and monthly Rho Kappa meetings throughout the year (2 misses only)
- 6. Attend one (1) field trip

Disgualification/ Removal from Rho Kappa

The following actions or lack of actions will lead to removal of the member from Rho Kappa:

- 1. Failure to continually meet GPA requirements
- 2. Failure to complete the service requirement
- 3. Failure to participate in one (1) fundraiser
- 4. Failure to continually meet character requirements in the classroom
- 5. Failure to attend one (1) field trip
