



Mass Shooting at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida By: Mark Lepine

On the 14th of February, there was a school shooting in Parkland, Florida leaving 17 people dead and wounding many more. The shooter was a former student named Nikolas Cruz (19 years old). Some of Cruz's former classmates describe him as being a loner when he attended the high school, and he was expelled from the school due to disciplinary reasons. Cruz went to the high school with a loaded AR-15 semiautomatic rifle and multiple magazines. He pulled the fire alarm in the school to draw students and teachers out of the classrooms. It is suspected that he even concealed himself in the crowd of students as they fled the school. Cruz was involved with the high school's Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (JROTC) program, his name was listed under several academic awards in 2016, these awards included academic achievement for maintaining an A in the JROTC, and a B in all other subjects. He consistently presented an outstanding appearance and an outstanding conduct throughout school. Cruz was adopted at birth by an older couple. His father passed away over a decade ago due to a heart attack, and his mother died more than three months ago, on November 1st after battling with the flu and pneumonia. He had been living with a friend's family since his mother died. Cruz had legally bought the AR-15 rifle, he passed the background check as well, and had the rifle before he moved in with the family. Prior to the shooting, Cruz had been posting disturbing pictures on Instagram, some showing off his collection of guns and knives, and others of him wearing a hat with a bandana around his face holding his knives in his hand. After the shooting took place, he was found by police and arrested. Cruz did not put up a fight and just let it happen. This incident has left many

people traumatized, and has left the families of the people who were killed, devastated.

Recently there was a school shooting in Florida, at the high-school called Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School, a public school of some 3,000 students outside Boca Raton. The shooting is among 10 of the deadliest mass shootings in modern US history. Things like this are only going to push gun control laws to be even stricter and looked down upon. This mass shooting was a high casualty one, with 17 people dying. The Broward County Schools says it has prepared their students for situations like this. Electric Semis

Elon Musk is trying to enter a new market and is trying to change the way goods are transported. It is a great idea but there are some design flaws that make it almost impossible to pull off. First off the idea is great, semis produced just in 2013, 530 million metric tons of carbon dioxide. That is about 12.5% of the U.S total of 6,673 metric tons of emissions in 2013. Also Elon Musk is offering an auto-pilot mode which he says will be even more efficient and safe. About 4,000 Americans die a year because of semi-truck accidents, so yes it would help with emissions and improve safety greatly but there is one thing stopping him from making this happen. Elon Musk is offering two different semi's, one with a travel range of 300 miles and one with a 500 mile travel range. The problem is the amount of technology and batteries in the semi takes up the majority of the weight, the semi will not be able to carry much cargo if these semis are to be able to travel up to 500 miles, because of all of the batteries and technology. So, the amount of cargo that these electric semis could carry is limited severely. Also charging these trucks takes much longer to charge than filling up a diesel truck, so for long hauls the company's would most likely need to set up a battery swapping or exchange stations. In turn these semis will cost slightly less to maintain but they will not be able to carry as many goods as a diesel semi-truck. I believe that because of this, these companies will never buy into Elon Musk's electric semi even though it would help emissions greatly. These companies won't spend more money and time if

they don't have to.



Bailey: As our season continues, what are some things you think we should work on in order to be




successful at States?





The opening ceremony started at 8pm. Spectators were seated in a stadium that held 35,000 people. These spectators were each given hats, raincoats, blankets, and hand, feet and seat warmers. The weather was 27' Fahrenheit with a wind chill factor of below 16' Fahrenheit. The theme was "Peace in Motion." There were 20,000 fireworks set off for the show. Five children were the stars of the show. Haenaroe, Ara, Puri, Bichae and Nuri travelled through time to the past and future, learning about South Korea's history and culture. In the 2018 Winter Olympics, one very important event occurred. Both North and South Korea participated in the games together. During the opening ceremony, both Korea's marched under a flag of unification. This was the first time ever this event occurred. There were 145 South

Korean athletes and 22 North Korean athletes holding up a Korean peninsula flag. The president of South Korea, Moon Jae-in and the North Korean president's sister even exchanged handshakes and well wishes.

As the trade deadline approaches in the national hockey league, there are two teams in a close race for first. The Tampa Bay Lightning and the first-year franchise, Las Vegas Golden Knights. Both of these teams are playing hockey very well at the moment, having more wins than any other team in the league. Ronaldo has scored more Championship League goals on his own than 87% of teams to have ever played in this competition. He is also holding the most goals scored in a season with his 2013-2014 record at 17 goals. Outstandingly he is also the only player ever to score 10+ goals in six different Champions League seasons. Ronaldo practically lives in the penalty zone with 86 out of his 100 goals are inside the box. He is dominantly right footed with a lot of his goals coming from his right foot but he clearly can show he has no problem shooting with his left.

In Cristiano Ronaldo's latest game, he pulled Real Madrid out of being down 1-0 against PSG by scoring 2 goals. Teammate Marcelo scored the 3rd goal for real Madrid to take the win. Ronaldo was

putting the pressure on the entire first half by firing 8 shots. PSG's goalie, Kevin Trapp, was doing an outstanding job by stopping Ronaldo, but, he was unable to stop the 2 in the 2nd half. Final score 3 - 1 Real Madrid.




Donald Trump By: Jason Milsom

- 8.) Take the Peep Bunnies, and a toothpick for each one. Insert the toothpick half way into the base of the Peep Bunny. Then insert the other side of the toothpick into the cake so the bunnies are poking out of the cake.
- 9.) Use the can of the orange decorating cake icing and make the carrots. To make the carrots, use the picture to help you design them and where to place them. Use the green icing to put the roots of the carrots on top of the orange carrots. Repeat this step for each carrot you make. To serve the cake, cut the cake into 4 rows by 3 rows.

- .½ Cups of Sugar . 2 tsp. Cream of Tartar
- . 2 TB Sugar

Step 1: Grab a mixing bowl. Start by mixing the **flour, Cream of tartar, salt,** and **baking soda.** Stir until ingredients are mixed thoroughly. Once ingredients are mixed thoroughly, set the mixing bowl to the side. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Step 2: In a separate mixing bowl, add in sugar. After that put in the soft butter, then add the two eggs. Make sure to also mix this bowl. Make sure to blend the ingredients thoroughly till it's all mixed up.

Step 3: Once both bowls are mixed, it's time to merge them! Take the ingredients from the dry bowl to the wet bowl. Going along the same lines as the past two steps, mix all the ingredients thoroughly. Prepare a side dish of a mix of sugar and cinnamon.

Step 4: Once the ingredients have formed into a dough form, take out the dough and begin to knead it. Once the dough is kneaded enough turn the dough into a bunch of small balls. After that you must roll each dough ball in the sugar and cinnamon mixture.

Step 5: Place each of your sugar and cinnamon balls on a non-greased cookie sheet. Make sure each dough ball is nearly 2 inches apart so that your snickerdoodles won't to each other.

<u>Step 6:</u> Place cookie sheet in the oven at 350 degrees. Allow the cookies to cook for about 8-10 minutes. Once ready, take your tasty batch of snickerdoodles and let them sit for 5-10 minutes to cool down.



Sugar Cookies By: Alana Nichols

Ingredients

¾ teaspoon kosher salt

½ teaspoon baking powder

3 cups all-purpose flour, plus more for rolling

1 ¼ cups (2 ½ sticks) chilled unsalted butter, cut into ½ inch pieces

1 cup sugar

1 large egg

1 large egg yolk

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Preparation

Whisk salt, baking powder, and 3 cups flour in a small bowl. Using an electric mixer on high speed, beat butter and sugar until well combined (butter does not need to be fluffed), about 3 minutes. Add egg, egg yolk, and vanilla; beat just to combine. Reduce speed to low and gradually add dry ingredients; mix just to combine. Form dough into two ¾ - thick disks; wrap in plastic. Chill at least 2 hours. Place racks in lower and upper thirds of oven; preheat to 325 degrees. Let 1 disk of dough sit at room temperature until softened slightly, about 5 minutes. Roll out on a lightly floured sheet of parchment paper until about 1/4 inch thick, dusting with flour as needed (if dough gets soft or sticky, chill on parchment until firm). Cut out shapes with floured cookie cutters; transfer to parchment-lined baking sheet. Bake cookies, rotating baking sheets halfway through, until edges are golden, 12-16 minutes, depending on size.

Transfer to wire racks and let cool. Repeat with scraps and remaining dough. **Decorate cooled cookies as desired!!!**
