

3 Ways to Request a Library Book

1) **YOU can place a hold in our library catalog**


Destiny (Library Catalog)

>Sign in (upper right corner)  then 

>Find & click on the book you would like. Ones marked “IN” are available now.

>Click HOLD. You will see a notice that you have 3 weeks to arrange a pickup.









>You are always able to view your current check-outs, holds, and profile

Go to top left corner  to see your information

The red “1” here indicates I have one hold ready. If you hold a book that is already checked out, it will let you know when it is available

How to GET the BOOKS:

Distribution Dates – East Senior will be having periodic pick up dates for materials.

Library books can be picked up during these times with prior arrangement by calling the number above.

Curbside Pick-Up - We are happy to meet you at the flagpole to give and/or receive books.

Once you have requested a book, you can call us when you arrive and we will come to your car.

Please make a prior arrangement so we don't miss your call when we are teaching, in a meeting, at lunch, etc. We do not want you to waste a trip so let us know approximately when you will be here.
