2021-22 Fall Sport Spectator Policies

Outdoor Sports - Football/Cross Country/Cheerleading/Soccer/Tennis

Masking and social distancing of a minimum of three feet apart are required by the Buffalo Public Schools at all District outdoor athletic events. Upon admission, all safety protocols must be strictly adhered to by spectators pursuant to this policy and the Buffalo Athletics COVID safety plan. Failure or refusal to abide by these policies may result in removal from the event and impact the individual's ability to attend future athletic contests.

Indoor Sports - Volleyball/Swimming

Temperature checks, the completion of a health questionnaire, masking, and social distancing will be required at all District indoor athletic events. Upon admission, all safety protocols must be strictly adhered to by the spectators pursuant to this policy and the Buffalo Athletics COVID safety plan. Failure or refusal to abide by these policies may result in removal from the event and impact the individual's ability to attend future athletic contests. Further, a spectator will not be admitted if a temperature reading at 100 degrees Fahrenheit or above is registered at the time of entry.

- This policy is subject to modifications and changes at the discretion of the District.
