

West Seneca Athletics Team & Spectator Guidelines (Indoors & Outdoors) Fall-2 Season

When you are attending athletic events at our facilities, we ask that you adhere to the following guidelines:

Spectators Guidelines:

• Face coverings and social distancing (6 ft) are required at all times.

• All spectators will be asked to "check in", Arrival no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the start of the contest. • Bathrooms will be available for use (indoors), Porta-Potties will be available for use (outdoors). Hand sanitizer stations will also be available. • Concessions will not be offered until further notice.

Spectator Capacity Limits (sport and venue specific):

• Football and Cheerleading (outdoor games)

- o 2 home & 2 away spectators permitted per rostered athlete.
- Home & Away spectators will be instructed to sit in designated bleachers.
- Spectators must be in the bleachers, no standing along the fence.

• Volleyball and Girls Swimming (Indoor contests)

• 2 home team spectators permitted per HOME rostered athlete

Team Guidelines:

- Coaches and all game personnel must wear a face covering at all times while on campus.
- Athletes must wear face coverings at all times, unless they cannot tolerate it during
- "active" play. Sidelines, bus, locker rooms, etc. are not considered "active" play areas.

• Athletes must provide their own water bottle..• Locker rooms will not be available for visiting teams. Please come dressed for gameplay.

• Opposing teams must provide a "gate list" prior to the start of the contest. The "gate list" should include a team roster, game personnel and any additional essential school staff members (football & cheerleading only).

• Opposing teams can arrive 60 minutes prior to the start of the contest for football and 30 minutes prior to the start of the game for volleyball.
