## SH Athletics Campus: COVID-19 Guidelines - Fall Season 2021

When you are attending events at our facilities, we are asking you to adhere with the following guidelines:

## **Indoor Events:**

- Facial coverings are required when students and spectators arrive on campus.
- Coaches, spectators and all other game personnel must wear a mask at all times while on campus indoors.
- Athletes (including opponents) are required to wear masks at all times during their activity unless a face covering cannot be tolerated.
- Locker rooms will not be available for opponents or officials. Please come dressed and ready to play.
- Spectators must wear a mask at all times while on campus and spectators must maintain a distance of 6 feet or greater between other spectators.
- Spectators, please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before the beginning of your contest.
- Bleachers and fields have been marked with tape and paint with social distancing markers for spectators to utilize.
- Coaches must remain with their team until all members of their team have left the campus.
- Players and coaches will avoid spitting, chewing gum, touching eyes, face, mouth etc.
- Coaches will utilize social distancing and face coverings during water breaks, huddles, moving around campus, beginning and end of game, bench areas and wherever possible during contests.
- Athletes, please do not arrive earlier than 60 minutes before your scheduled game.

## **Outdoor Events:**

- For spectators, facial coverings are not required but are encouraged when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Locker rooms will not be available for opponents or officials. Please come dressed and ready to play.
- Bathrooms will be available on a limited basis. Portable toilets will be available as well.
- Spectators, please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before the beginning of your contest.
- Bleachers and fields have been marked with tape for social distancing markers for spectators to utilize.
- Coaches must remain with their team until all members of their team have left the campus.
- Players and coaches will avoid spitting, chewing gum, touching eyes, face, mouth etc.
- Coaches will utilize social distancing during water breaks, huddles, moving around campus, beginning and end of game, bench areas and wherever possible during contests.
- The concession stand will be available for certain events.
- Athletes, please do not arrive earlier than 60 minutes before your scheduled game.
