

Williamsville East Athletics Campus Protocols Winter 2021

To student-athletes, coaches, staff, officials, administrators, parents, and patrons:

We are happy to have finally welcomed our student-athletes back to sports this Winter season! The health and safety of all individuals is our number one priority. We ask that you please adhere to the following guidelines when visiting our facilities:

- 1) Per NYSDOH guidance, proper facial coverings are required for all athletes (unless unable to tolerate a face covering for the physical activity), coaches, event staff, and officials.
- 2) Per Section VI guidance, spectators will not be permitted to any athletic events at this time.
- 3) There will be no shared towels, clothing, or water bottles. Please have your athletes bring their own water bottles.
- 4) Locker rooms are only available for lavatory use at this time. Please be sure your team comes dressed and prepared to participate in the contest.
- 5) Visiting teams are encouraged to bring their own basketballs for warm-ups. Williamsville East will do the same for their away games.
- 6) Away teams should report <u>no</u> earlier than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of your game.
- 7) At the halftime of basketball games, the away team will stay on their bench. The home team will meet in an extra gymnasium space.
- 8) The basketball scorer's table will only seat the scoreboard operator and shot clock operator. Both the home and away scorebook keepers will sit at socially distanced desks.
- 9) When traveling to and from away events, Williamsville East coaches and athletes will be screened and will wear appropriate facial coverings.
- 10) When traveling to Williamsville East for an athletic event, athletes will be screened prior to entering the facility. Any individual who presents a temperature greater than 100 degrees F will not be allowed entry into our facilities.

Procedures for arriving at Williamsville CSD buildings:

- 1) Williamsville East: enter at driveway near Chasewood Lane and enter the Athletics Door (Door #20); park in the lot near tennis courts.
- 2) Transit Middle School: enter at Athletic Door (Door #20); park in parking near athletic entrance
