

West Seneca Academic Eligibility Evaluation Form

According to the West Seneca Central School District's Academic Eligibility Policy, you have been deemed academically ineligible for your current sport or extracurricular activity.

In order to regain and maintain your eligibility for games or activities, you must complete the following five (5) week probation period, where you **MUST**:

- (1) seek remediation in the classes you are failing DAILY by staying after school with your teachers, and
- (2) abide by the teacher's discretion on when you may return to your sport or activity

Failure to successfully complete this probation period will strip you of your eligibility to take part in sports or extracurricular activities.

Special Circumstances:

If there are meetings after school, you **must** see your teachers for their feedback before the end of the class day.

If teacher of the failing class is not available after school, student must seek remediation from another teacher.

Teachers: *After the initial 2 weeks of probation*, you may determine when the student returns to eligible status. Please sign off when you feel the following parameters have been met.

- (1) The student has shown the proper motivation and work ethic/effort to be successful in your class, and/or
- (2) The student has elevated their grade in your class to a passing average of 65 or higher.

NOTES:

A student who loses their eligibility may regain their eligibility after 2 successful weeks of probation. However, that student must complete their 5 weeks of probation to stay eligible.

If the teacher feels the student is working to the best of their ability, the teacher may grant the student eligibility, even though their average is not up passing level. Once an average is at 65, they are considered passing.

This form is to be submitted by the coach/advisor at their final meeting with their supervisor.
