Contingency Schedules

The West Seneca Central School District is committed to ensuring a strong educational program for its students as we continue to navigate the Covid-19 pandemic. As we have seen throughout the public health emergency, schools must be prepared to pivot at any given moment as reflected in the current status of the county infection rate.

Therefore, the following information is being shared with you only in the event there is a change that necessitates a shift from our current instructional model so that you have an understanding of what that shift will look like.

In addition, the following are a few reminders that will help you to be prepared in the event such a change is warranted:

- Please be sure to bring home your chromebooks every day and ensure they are charged and ready to go.
- If a change in models is necessary, review the online learning etiquette guidelines (see Appendix A) for a positive learning experience.
- Ensure that your contact information is up to date so that we may get in touch with you if needed and for various district to home communications.
- Know the names and numbers of key personnel at your child(ren)'s buildings (see Appendix B).
