

STUDENT DRESS CODE

Student's dress, personal appearance, and cleanliness, like his/her conduct, should show respect for others, and promote a focus on learning. A student's dress, grooming and appearance should meet the following requirements:

1. Be safe, appropriate and not disrupt or interfere with the educational process.
2. Garments such as tube tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, bare midriffs and short shorts or skirts are not allowed.
3. Underwear must be completely covered with outer clothing. Pajamas or loungewear are not allowed.
4. Sturdy footwear must be worn at all times. Footwear that is a safety hazard, such as high heels or flip-flops, will not be allowed.
5. Hats, visors, or bandanas are not allowed in school.
6. Make-up and distracting hairstyles or hair colors are not allowed.
7. Jewelry that could cause injury to self or others is not allowed.
8. Items that are vulgar, obscene, libelous or denigrate others on account of race, color, religion/creed, national origin, gender, sexual orientation or disability are not allowed.
9. Items that promote and/or endorse the use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs and/or encourage other illegal activities, violence, or intimidation are not allowed.

Students who violate the student dress code will be required to change their appearance by covering or removing the offending item and, if necessary or practical, replacing it with an acceptable item.
