THURSDAY, APRIL 11

Depart West Seneca early this morning for Washington D.C. Meal/rest stops will be coordinated between the chaperones and the bus drivers. Upon arrival you'll go to the Smithsonian Museum Complex. The Smithsonian buildings line the Washington Mall area, and you may visit the National Art Gallery, the Air & Space Museum, the American History Museum, the Native American Museum, or any one of the other museum buildings, all within walking distance of one another. Depart D.C. for the Pentagon City Mall where you'll have dinner (individual's expense). You'll walk from the mall over to the Pentagon Memorial before departing for your suburban Virginia hotel, check in, and remain for the evening.

FRIDAY, APRIL 12

BREAKFAST. Today your group will enjoy the day sightseeing in Washington D.C., including a tour of the Capitol Building and a picture stop at the White House. You'll have time to visit the Smithsonian Museum Complex, where you'll also have lunch (individual's expense). Continue sightseeing this afternoon with a visit to the Newseum. **DINNER.** This evening, enjoy an illumination tour of the new Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial; the Vietnam Memorial; the Korean Memorial; the Lincoln, Jefferson, and Roosevelt Memorials, and the Washington Monument. Return to your hotel and remain for the evening.

SATURDAY, APRIL 13

BREAKFAST. This morning your group will travel to Arlington National Cemetery, where you will see the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. You will also see the Kennedy gravesites and also the Challenger memorial. Depart the cemetery for Pentagon City Mall for lunch (individual's expense). Following lunch your group will depart for the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum. The Holocaust Memorial Museum provides for the documentation, study, and interpretation of Holocaust history. It is dedicated to helping leaders and citizens of the world confront hatred, prevent genocide, promote human dignity, and strengthen democracy. You'll have **DINNER** this evening before departing for the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts where you'll attend a performance of *Shear Madness*. Return to your hotel following the show and remain for the evening.

SUNDAY, APRIL 14

BREAKFAST. Check out and depart the hotel for the Udvar-Hazy Air and Space Center. Lunch (individual's expense) before departing for West Seneca early this afternoon. Meal/rest stops will be coordinated between the chaperones and driver. Scheduled late evening arrival at the school.

PROGRAM FEE: \$ 579/person based on 40-50 students and four chaperones PER BUS

FEE INCLUDES: Round trip motorcoach transportation between West Seneca and Washington D.C.; accommodations for three nights, with students four to a room and the chaperones two to a room; three breakfasts; two dinners; local D.C. guides; security guard service at the hotel each night; sightseeing as listed, including required admissions; gratuities to the guides and the bus drivers; all hotel/restaurant taxes and gratuities.

NOT INCLUDED: Meals other than those listed; baggage handling; items of a personal nature.
