SPECTATOR PROTOCOLS & CODE OF CONDUCT





SPECTATOR PROTOCOLS

- Indoor Sporting Contests Home team students aged 19 and younger may attend without an adult. Away team students aged 19 and younger must be accompanied by an adult throughout the duration of the contest.
- Outdoor Sporting Contests Home and away team students aged 19 and younger must be accompanied by an adult throughout the duration of the contest.
- **Photo ID** Spectators are required to have valid photo ID to display upon request.
- **Entry** Spectators are required to cooperate with all safety and security check points (Evolv system, wanding, visual possession and bag checks).
- Admissions \$5.00 cash or \$3.00 Go Fan per person for all spectators aged six and up.
- Seating Home and Away team spectators are required to sit in designated seating sections. Spectators are not permitted in the playing area before, during or after a contest.
- **Reentry** Spectators will not be authorized for re-entry after leaving the event.
- Bags For outdoor sporting contests, book bags, large purses (exceeding 4.5" x 6.5"), and totes will not be permitted inside the venue. Exceptions may be made for small medical bags (not to exceed 4.5" x6.5"). All bags will be subject to a search. See below.
- Pets Animals are not permitted on the facilities. Exceptions may be considered for registered service animals.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Spectators shall respect and obey all referees, teams, game management and security. Spectators should serve as role models through positive behavior and good sportsmanship.
- Spectators are not allowed to enter the competition area, prior to, during or after the conclusion of the contests. Violators are subject to removal from the venue.
- Inappropriate language, actions, violence or threat of violence will not be tolerated before, during, or after the contest and will result in immediate removal from the venue.
- No loitering or wandering inside or outside of the venue.
- No weapons, alcohol, tobacco, drugs or vapes are permitted inside the venue.

Game officials and school district personnel are authorized to remove spectators. Adult spectators who are removed from the contest will not receive a refund and may be required to complete the National Federation of High Schools (NFHS), Parent Credential Course or serve a suspension before they are permitted to return. Student spectators who are removed will not receive a refund and be held accountable in accordance to BPS Student Code of Conduct. BPS reserves the right to close admissions at any time throughout the duration of the contest.
