HOW TO LOCATE BOOKS:

1. West Middle school library:

- a. Destiny: <http://libraries.wscschools.org> (print books, ebooks and audiobooks)
- b. Students may log in to search the Destiny catalog using their school Google account.
- c. Students may check out print books from the school library in June before school ends and return them by September; E-books and audio books may be checked out any time online in Destiny or Sora. Destiny search results will include any copies of a title available in Sora.
- d. Sora: <http://www.SoraApp.com> (ebooks and audiobooks) **Sora now adds content from the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library to your school account automatically – no public library card needed!*
