NO ONE will be turned away on the first visit. Continued eligibility will be determined with application at first visit.

Operating hours include every **Tuesday from 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m.** and the **2**nd **Saturday of the month from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon.**
