

Dear Families,

As you are aware, Erie County is currently under a state of emergency and schools are closed. Additionally, county officials have directed people to practice social distancing and to avoid gathering in groups. However, we understand that some of our students have medication in school that is essential to their health and well-being. Therefore, we are allowing parents to pick up medication from their child's school on **Tuesday, March 17, 2020**, between the hours of **11:00 AM - 1:00 PM**. Once again, only medication that is **medically essential** should be picked up as we are trying to minimize contact between people.

Anyone picking up medication other than a custodial parent must bring a letter signed by the custodial parent giving them permission to do so. Such an individual must also present identification to the school nurse before the medication will be released. Thank you, in advance, for your support and understanding as we navigate this national emergency.
