Dear Members of the West Seneca Central School District Community,

As was communicated yesterday, based upon the guidance of the Erie County Health Commissioner, the West Seneca Central School District is cancelling all school-sponsored travel planned to destinations outside of Western New York due to concerns related to COVID-19. The ban on school-based travel applies to students and to staff, and will continue through the month of April and possibly longer if necessary.

Additionally, effective immediately and until further notice, we are suspending all public West Seneca Central School District gatherings that include more than 50 people. Gatherings within our schools that include only our students and staff, such as assemblies, professional learning, student government meetings, etc. will continue as normal. Examples of public gatherings of more than 50 people that will be suspended are concerts, public forums, and spectators attending sporting events.

The circumstances around this looming public health challenge seem to change rapidly. We will take action according to those circumstances, with the guidance of public health officials, in an effort to assure the safety of everyone who learns, works and visits in our schools.

I will continue to communicate directly with families, as events require.
